

Glassonby Parish Council Meeting 5th September 2018 7.30 at Gamblesby Community Centre - Minutes

Planning Matters – 18/0656 – Gamblesby Methodist Church – Alterations inc disabled access – In Circulation
18/0421 – Nutwood Melmerby (Ousby Parish) – letter of objection sent since last meeting.

Highway Matters – Road Markings still missing at Maughanby School junction. Drain cover at Beck Hill Glassonby damaged. Several potholes in Unthank. The potholes in Gamblesby had all been filled along with the potholes in the passing places. There had been several complaints about the portable toilet and skip outside the old chapel which appeared to have become a permanent fixture, the clerk to contact the resident. The gulleys in the Parish were still in need of being cleaned out. The Clerk to chase up the Highways team again. The presence of PC Labram in Gamblesby had a good effect on speeding within the village.

Devolution and Transfer of Assets – A vote was taken to adopt the footway lighting, the majority voted to take on the lighting for the Parish. Mr D Henderson and Mr R Henry to sort this before the 30th September deadline.

LonsdaleNET – A draft wayleave had been requested again for the system that crosses the village green. Mr R Henry proposed that we encourage the community group to arrange a meeting with Lonsdale Net to get a full update and deadline for completion in Gamblesby and connection to Unthank.

Letter of complaint about Dog Fouling in Glassonby – Mr R Henry to speak to resident.

Gamblesby Play Area – Fundraising in progress with events being held up to Christmas.

Village Green reinstatement. - Add to next meeting agenda.

Emergency / Community Resilience Action Plan – Copies of Langwathby's plan had been circulated prior to the meeting. The Clerk to sort out a plan for the Parish. Ms C Driver proposed that we hold an extraordinary meeting mid October with Karl Melville and Keith Little to discuss a winter management plan for 2018 onwards. It was agreed this was a great idea. Miss C Driver to liaise with the chairman and the clerk.

Defibrillators installation – The Gamblesby Kiosk sign over had now been completed awaiting confirmation for Glassonby Kiosk. The Clerk to chase up.

Maintenance of the Coronation bench in Gamblesby – Mr D Henderson volunteered to tidy up the area around the bench and repair the bench.

Comments from members of the public – Mr A Dyer pointed out that the road near the children's play area was in need or being repaired. The Clerk to report to highways. Mr R Henry suggested a note go out to all residents to remind them of the dog fouling problems in both villages along with speeding and the stones that residents have placed on the verges outside their properties. Mrs J Sawyer had sent an email with regards to the lack of attendance at the ceremony for Mr Beatham who was awarded the Victoria cross, the chairman had sent his apologies.
