**Defibrillators installation** – These have both been installed and a training course was held which was well attended by the Parishioners. An informal meeting with the children in Gamblesby is to be planned to show them what's inside the defibrillator box. Mr R Henry thanked Mr M Wilson for all his work repairing the Gamblesby phone box and to Mrs Morton for preparing and undercoating the phone box. The top coat is still to apply. The Glassonby Phone box also requires painting. The Clerk to order location signs and stickers for the inside of box kiosks. Sarah Braithwaite has also been formally asked to take care of the Glassonby Defibrillator.

**Comments from members of the public :** The Parents of children being transported to Langwathby school has asked that the removal of the bus escorts be mentioned at the meeting. The Parents feel that this is a very important and would like the support of the Parish Council to help retain them. Mr R Henry talked about the importance of our community responding to climate change and would like to add this to the agenda for the next meeting.
