**Planning Matters** –Rosebank Unthank , This was approved by EDC however GPC were never notified- there were no objections by the PC.

**Highway Matters** . - Westgarth Lonning had been reported to CC, Bridge on Gamblesby to Melmerby Road is in the process of being repaired , Tree at Sweetwell has been reported. Voil moor has been reported several times but is still an ongoing problem. Back Lane in Glassonby has also been reported. Lacey Caves footpath remains closed but an application has been recently submitted to re-route part of the walk. The clerk to check Hazlerigg Bridge and Low Farm culvert to check if they had been checked in the last two years .

**Tree inspections** – Waiting for inspector to look at them and submit a price.

**Gamblesby Cricket Pitch** – Negotiations ongoing with the trust and Mr R Henry

**Gamblesby Play area** – Over £800 was raised at the Christmas Bingo and raffle . The PC to write to ask for an update on progress, Mrs C Driver mentioned that there is lots of funding available at the moment.

**Climate Change** – Sub committee had a recent meeting and had drafted a newsletter. (copies were distributed) This would be distributed if there were no amendments to be made. A Facebook page had been created but had not gone live yet.

**Emergency / Community Resilience Action Plan** – Mr R Henry, Mr D Henderson and the Clerk to work on.

**Reports from District and County Councillor** – Miss C Driver reported that lots was going on with Health and scrutiny, mainly connected with getting people out of hospitals along with care packages for the elderly. The Grit for the Parish had been delivered and the weather station at Unthank was live . Mr D Henderson would contact Karl Melville with the email address to obtain access. Mr D Banks reported that the waste contract was due for renewal in 2022 .
