Account update and annual donations – Last years accounts were approved the risk assessment was also approved. The clerk to get a copy of the accounts from the first responders and Addingham church.

Planning – 20/0041 Honeysuckle House – No objections and plans approved by EDC

20/0591 – Church Farm Gamblesby – plans in circulation.

20/0446 – Low Farm Gamblesby – No objections and plans approved by EDC

20/0331 – Midtown Farm – No objection TPO put on tree then removed and application approved by EDC

Highways - Maughanby to Gamblesby road trees overhanging road to be reported, voil moor still an ongoing problem . Culvert at Unthank road end blocked to report. The clerk to check when Hazlerigg bridge was last inspected. The Tree survey report was received a few jobs to be done by the Parish Councillors and the larger trees to be inspected further.

Cricket Pitch – A lease to be drawn up . Mr R Henry to sort this. The Allotment society are happy for the Parish Council to take over this.

Gamblesby Play area and Glassonby safety report received .

Climate Change – No meeting have taken place due to covid. Mr D Henderson to organise a meeting.

Glassonby Village hall – Mr P Clarke updated the Parish Council. The Hall is not a responsibility of the Parish Council. The Parish council is a holding trustee because the committee can't own property but have no rights and can only act under instruction from the committee

Gamblesby Village green - letter from Chapel re Harvest Festival there were no objection.

Coronavirus round up from the Parish – The Parish Council thanked Dori and Dave Henderson for all their hard work with the daily emails providing information to resident. The last six months had been a challenging time for the Parish but seeing how the community pulled together helping each other showed great community spirit. Miss C Driver asked if the parish could put together a list of items that the council could do or help with to have made things better for the parish . This could be how information is obtained / distributed.

Winter gritting plans - Nothing from the information that we contributed for the information on the gritting routes had gone to cabinet yet due to covid.

Reports from District and County Councillors - There is a massive push at present to do away with EDC and Council Council and have a mayor.

The Treasurers reported that last year income and expenditure was in line with budget the increases being the insurance for the new footway lighting Opening balance £2042.80 receipts of £5451.33 expenses £4138.42 which leaves a balance of £3355.71 . The increase in the opening balance is due to the increase in precept and two annual donations not made.
