

# **Glassonby Parish Council Meeting Thursday 28<sup>th</sup> July – Gamblesby Community Centre – Including open meeting – Draft Minutes**

**Clerk Report** - A Letter of thanks from Hartside responders had been received. Accounts had been received from Addingham Church Churchyard account it was agreed to send our annual donation of £100 and include £100 from last year which was missed. The culvert on Two Briggs corner had been reported to Highways and was to be inspected.

**Highways** – .Mr A Relph reported that lots of pot holes down Dale Raven. The gullies on Far lands and Beck hill need cleaning out. Mr M Wilson reported that the potholes from Melmerby to Hazlerigg have been repaired. The Grate on Hazlerigg corner is full again. The culvert above the Unthank junction from Gamblesby looks to be subsiding. The Clerk to report these items to Highways.

**Cricket Pitch** – update on draft document – No Progress yet

**Climate Change** - There are lots of challenges ahead to get the Parishioners engaged with what we can do to help combat climate change. The Parish Council would arrange a open meeting at a later date to try and get the community involved.

**Winter Gritting Plan** - Still waiting for an update.

**Glassonby Parish** Councillor co-option – Two Parishioners had applied and after a vote Mr S Hodgson was co-opted on by majority.

**B4RN Broadband** - Mr D Henderson gave an update on the installation. A meeting has been arranged for the 28th August. The proposed installation would mean crossing the boundary wall over the Cricket Field. The Parish Councillors were happy to agree to a wayleave across the field. Mr D Henderson would sort out the written wayleave.

**Footway Lighting** – The Maintenance Contract was discussed The Clerk to ask the Clerk for Langwathby what Langwathby Parish Council are doing.

**Standing Order** – A review of the Standing orders was requested by Mr D Henderson to make sure that the Parish compliant. These haven't been reviewed since they were adopted. Mr D Henderson would draft a list up of items that may need reviewing.

**Meeting Dates** – Mr D Henderson proposed we change the meeting date so the clerk had time to get the minutes in the MEMO. It was agreed to keep the date the same (last wednesday in the month) for the next couple of meetings then review it.

**Eden Rivers Trust** – ERT are holding a Balsam Bashing day on Saturday the 7<sup>th</sup> August at Glassonby if any residents would like to attend.

**Glassonby Village Hall Update** – Glassonby Village Hall Committee had now reformed and would be in charge of any future plans for the Village Hall.

**Reports from District Councillors** – Mr D Banks and Miss C Driver reported that there is a lot going on with regards to the Local Government reorganisation . There would be an opportunity for Parish's and organisations to give their views. The County Council elections have been deferred until 2023, but bi-elections can take place. A new policy review would take place in connection with Footway lighting. The outbreak management fund is available for groups wishing to put on an event to bring the community together.
