Highway Matters: Mr G Morton reported that the pot holes that were filled in by a contractor called velocity had not been done very well. A dry mix had been put in and this had not been wacked down and would not last very long. Mary Robinson said she would report this at the next County Council meeting that week. There was nothing to report from Mr A Marsden about Gamblesby. Mr A Relph reported that the road repair opposite The White House was not great. There is a missing give way sign on Lowry cross on the Maughanby side. The Clerk to report this. The Glassonby Sign had been made but hadn't been fitted yet.

**Gamblesby Swings:** Mr A Marsden reported that a grant application for £3120 Inc Vat was filled in and would be submitted this week.

**Street Lighting:** The Light outside Croft House Farm has been agreed to be replaced however the Light in the middle of Unthank has not. The Clerk has informed Chris Slater, as this is the one where the Children's bus stops but has had no reply. If the Parish Would like to purchase a light it would cost £2500.00.

**Grass Cutting**: Invoice received from Mr T Kemp for £100 authorised by the Parish Council for part of Glassonby Grass cutting. The Parish to get tenders in for this years grass cutting in both villages for next meeting.

**Parish Council website:** Transparency grant application has been filled in by Mr R Henry with help from the Clerk. It has been sent to CALC who were going to check it and send it in.

**Standing Orders and Freedom of Information Policy:** This is 95% complete. Mr R Henry proposed to hold a working group meeting to finalise the policy for the next meeting.

Robert Beatham Plaque: The Parish Councillors agreed that it was a good idea to site the plaque that was in the old Chapel at the Church. Mr R Hodgson, Mr T Kemp and Mr P Clark would have a look around the village to find a suitable place for the new plaque that is due to be made in 2017. The thought was that it may be best situated near the Bus shelter in the centre of the village.

Comments from Members of the Public: Mr R Henry reported that he had booked himself on a good councillor course at CALC. Mrs M Robinson spoke about the Devolution of powers and the Cumbrian deal that was in negotiation. Although this may not affect our Parish much it would have a big effect on the town Parish council and other Parish Councils in our area. Mr R Hodgson asked the Parish Councillors if the Parish Councillors had any objections in increasing the Parish Council meetings from 5 to 6. These would take place on Jan, March, May, July, September and November so there was not too much of a gap between meetings. This was proposed by R Hodgson and Seconded by Mr P Clark, The majority of the Parish Councillors were in favour.
