Comments from members of the Public – Two members of the public raised concerns about the beck which runs through the village. At the last flood the amount of water coming down flooded their outbuilding and has caused damaged to the sandstone wall at Mill House. Concerns were also raised about work that had been undertaken in the beck over the last few days, Mrs M Robinson would raise this issue with highways,

Reports from Councillors : Currently Mrs M Robinson is busy distributing and collecting housing surveys.

Clerks Report – Work has been completed on the tree in the Glassonby play area.

Planning – Trees to be removed between Little Roods and Sunnymorn, these trees have ash die back.

Highways - The 20mph speed limit has been granted for Glassonby and Gamblesby and is through to the next steps. There are several gullys in the parish that are still blocked up. The clerk to ask for the sweeper to visit the parish. The manhole outside the Smithy in Gamblesby to report, Broken gully grate below Lowry cross, Lots of pot holes towards Glassonby Beck and potholes on Robberby Road.

Parish Tree Report – The tree work at Glassonby Play area completed. A quote for the removal of three trees towards the cricket pitch has been received – it was agreed to go ahead with this.
